

Africa Safari Lake Manyara lies between the foothills of Ngorongoro Crater and Lake Manyara, but even more striking is its location, which could easily be mistaken for the middle of a national park. Because of the large number of animals that are permanently present on the lodge's premises, end of 2021 the area and its surroundings have been declared a Game Controlled Area (GCA).

The accommodation is a safari in itself with different room types spread across the various sites. The Luxury Glamping accommodations are reached by walking through the subtle bush to your own private 'safari cabin', complete with hammock, raised wooden deck, living room and beautiful rustic wooden interior. The premium bungalows share the


same view as the restaurant area and you can't imagine being closer to the wildlife. The Safari Comfort accommodations are spacious, and comfortable, having exterior canvas walls, a concrete floor and a permanent bathroom.

The swimming pool with sun loungers and umbrellas is conveniently located near the bar and main buildings. The solidly built restaurant offers a magnificent view of Lake Manyara itself.

Africa Safari Lake Manyara is considered a wildlife lodge and overnight stays are subject to GCA fees.

Africa Safari Lake Manyara is located on the shores of Lake Manyara, near the lively village Mto wa Mbu and the Lake Manyara airstrip. A location ideal to explore Lake Manyara and Tarangire National Parks and/or Ngorongoro Crater. Also perfect as a stopover on your way to Serengeti National Park.


PARK INFORMATION

What you should know

Although Africa Safari Lake Manyara is not in a national park, WMA conservation & bed night fees do apply. These apply to both people and vehicles. Agents must pay these fees electronically online, whilst for private visitors Africa Safari Lake Manyara can assist.

Ngorongoro (both Crater and Conservation Area) and Lake Manyara and Tarangire National Parks have their own park entry/conservation fees, and these too are best applied for and paid in advance online.

- 2x a 40m² bungalow, equipped with a king-size bed. Extra single bed on request. Complete with a walk-in shower, a European toilet and a washbasin. Outside seating area on the balcony, overlooking the Lake.
- 1x a 60m² bungalow, equipped with a king-size bed and 3 single beds. Complete with a walk-in shower, a European toilet and a washbasin. Outside seating area of 15m² on the balcony, overlooking the lake.

The Safari tents are situated almost next to the pool, overviewing the whole property. With 2 single beds inside and a small seating


to go back to basics. There are 3 tents available.














TAWA Game Controlled Area

By paying the Wildlife Management Area fee, daytime access to the "Mto wa Mbu GCA", which includes the Jangwani Wildlife Corridor, is included. The Jangwani Corridor is approximately 3.5 km wide and 20-25 km long and runs along the eastern boundary of Lake Manyara National Park. It is part of the larger Upper Kitete Corridor. These corridors facilitate migration, prevent inbreeding, keep species such as zebra, wildebeest, buffalo, eland, elephant and hippo healthy and provide an escape route if an area becomes temporarily unstable. If the water level of the lake allows it, this is an excellent area for walking and/or a birdwatching trip.



Ngorongoro Crater

Nothing can prepare you for the breathtaking beauty of Ngorongoro Crater. Standing on the viewpoint and beholding the crater, the clouds floating around the crater rim with a cool, mountainous breeze in the air, there is no mistaking the divinity of Mother Nature. Ngorongoro Crater is a world heritage site, the world's largest intact volcanic caldera and is widely referred to as the 8th Wonder of the World. Due to its natural boundaries, there is an abundance of wildlife in the protected area which is home to the Big Five including the African black rhino, but you will also find hyenas, zebras and elephants to name but a few. The Ngorongoro Crater is an absolute must on any northern tour.



Tarangire National Park

Tarangire National Park is a fun and easy park to explore. The game is abundant and exposed because the park is more compact and the terrain is open. In the dry season, the Tarangire River is the only permanent source of water. Tarangire NP is 2850 square kilometres in size, making it the sixth largest park in Tanzania. It offers the highest concentration of wildlife after the Serengeti. Tarangire is known for its Baobab trees and the large herds of elephants that can be seen from close by. Other animals that can be seen in Tarangire are: wildebeests, zebras, buffaloes, gazelles, rhinos, warthogs, impalas, pythons, lions, leopards and almost 500 species of birds.

Lake Manyara National Park

Lake Manyara National Park, an underrated gem among safari parks, offers great ecological diversity in a small area. The alkaline soda of the lake attracts impressive numbers of birds that thrive on the water. More than 400 species have been identified and one of the highlights is the thousands of flamingos. From the park's main entrance, the road winds through an area of groundwater forests. On the grassy banks of the lake, wildebeest, giraffe, zebra and the great buffalo can be seen grazing throughout the day. The park also offers excellent opportunities for hippo watching. The mahogany and acacia trees are inhabited by the famous tree-climbing lions; with a bit of luck you may see them lazing on a tree branch.

BIKING AT MTO WA MBU VILLAGE

A great way to get some exercise and explore rural life on two wheels! Enjoy a bike ride through the lively village, past local farms, schools and churches, combined with breathtaking views of the valley and lake.

Get ready for an adrenaline boost at the Zipline Adventure park! Located at the foot of the Great Rift Valley, the course offers 4 exciting zips and 5 eco platforms. In a safety harness, you glide on a cable between the ancient Baobab trees while enjoying the breathtaking views of the Maasai land.



MAASAI BOMA TOUR AT MTO WA MBU

Maasai are easily recognised by their bright red blankets and colourful beadwork. These semi-nomadic people are warlike herdsmen. Their lives revolve around gathering and grazing large herds of cows, as they believe that they are the guardians of all the cattle in the world. During your visit to their homestead, called a manyatta, the Maasai will teach you the Adumu (their world-famous jumping dance) and you will learn more about their beads and crafts.



GUIDED BIRD WATCHING

_

Bring your binoculars! You travel by car to the entrance of Lake Manyara, or depending on the water level in the lake, to the Jangwani Corridor. As it is not allowed to enter the park itself on foot, these buffer zones are excellent birding areas where you can walk and watch. This area is home to a wide cross-section of Tanzania's many bird species, making Lake Manyara one of the best birding hotspots in East Africa.

Add some height to your safari in Lake Manyara National Park. Experience an adventure in the lush canopy of the forest. With this 370 metre aerial walk, you gradually rise from the ground to a total height of 18 metres, while viewing the surrounding nature and wildlife from an extraordinary perspective.

Early in the morning the passengers arrive in time to see the balloon inflate when the pilots blow the coloured fabric to life. The flight lasts for an hour each day a different path according to the prevailing winds of the day. A balloon flight lets passengers soar over the world's most spectacular Tarangire National Park where you can see two of the 'Giants of the African Wilderness': the elephants and the Baobab trees.

DEVELOPMENTS

Lake Manyara drains water from a few permanent and seasonal rivers from the Karatu Highlands, the Ngorongoro, Mbulu and the Nou forest. The lake influences local land use practises and attracts many wildlife. It sustains the Tarangire- Manyara Ecosystem in Northern Tanzania by being one of the two catchment basins and is therefore very important for conservation.




