

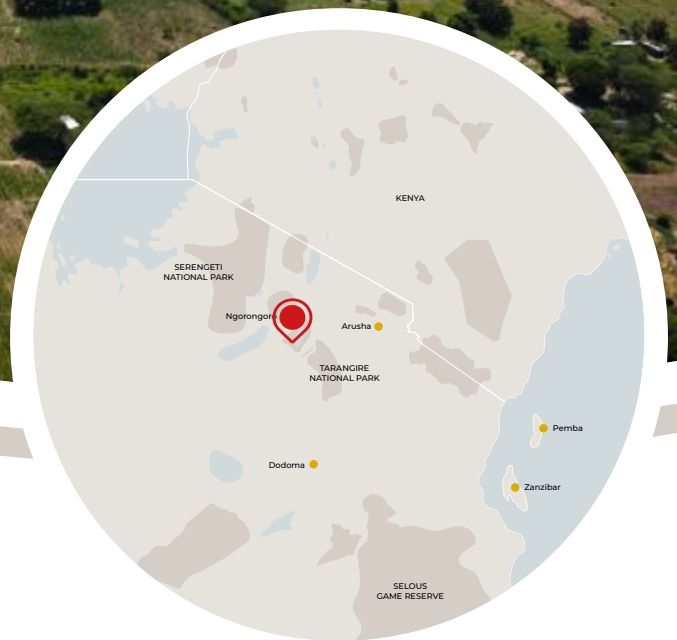
Africa Safari Rift Valley

Africa Safari Rift Valley is located in the village Mayoka, on the south side of Lake Manyara with the famous Great Rift Valley as its surroundings. It's the perfect location to relax before or after visiting Tanzania's northern National Parks, conveniently located between Tarangire and Lake Manyara. Africa Safari Rift Valley's location is off the beaten track. At this location, we offer different tent categories, the Safari Comfort Accommodation, Safari Luxury Accommodations and the Safari Tents. The Safari Luxury Accommodations have a raised wooden deck, living room with a comfortable sofa, a beautiful rustic wooden interior and an outside shower where you can shower under the sun, moon and starry sky. The Safari Comfort Accommodations are spacious and comfortable, with exterior canvas walls, a tarpaulin floor and a permanent bathroom. The swimming pool and restaurant is embedded in the surrounding landscape and offers a beautiful view of the Rift Valley and Lake Manyara. The southern entrance of Lake Manyara National Park, Iyambi Gate, is only a short distance away, this National Park has a variety of

wildlife including the famous tree climbing lions. Lake Manyara National Park is a sanctuary for the hippo, giraffe, impala and zebra, and the lake of Manyara a magnet for bird life. The west of Tarangire National Park, Sangaiwe Gate, is less than an hour drive away. Tarangire National Park is known for its high number of scenic baobab trees, and is home to the largest population of elephants in Northern Tanzania. Tanzania is the third largest sugar producer in East Africa. Just a 30 minute ride away from Africa Safari Rift Valley you will find the Manyara Sugar Factory, one of the factories contributing to producing sugar.

The accommodation owes its name to the famous Rift Valley, which is one of the Natural Wonders of the World.

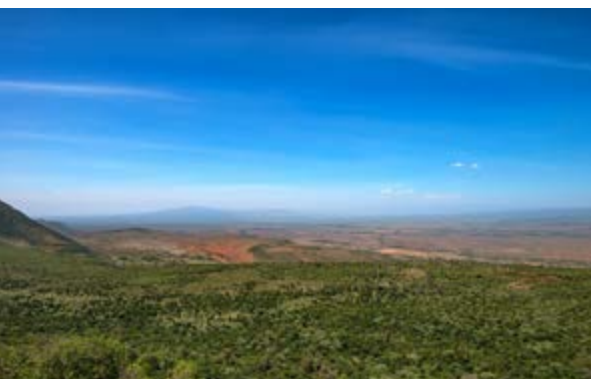


LOCATION

Tourists can access Lake Manyara National Park through different access gates located in the northern and southern parts of the National Park. The northern gate is commonly used by tourists visiting the destination, but from Africa Safari Rift Valley the southern gate, Iyambi Gate, is the gate to enter the National Park. To access Lake Manyara National Park visitors are required to pay entrance fees.

Lake Manyara National Park

Lake Manyara National Park, an underrated gem among safari parks, offers great ecological diversity in a small area. The alkaline soda of the lake attracts impressive numbers of birds that thrive on the water. More than 400 species have been identified and one of the highlights is the thousands of flamingos. From the park's main entrance, the road winds through an area of groundwater forests.

On the grassy banks of the lake, wildebeest, giraffe, zebra and the great buffalo can be seen grazing throughout the day. The park also offers excellent opportunities for hippo watching. The mahogany and acacia trees are inhabited by the famous tree-climbing lions; with a bit of luck you may see them lazing on tree branches.



Tarangire National Park

Tarangire National Park is a fun and easy park to explore. The game is abundant and exposed because the park is more compact and the terrain is open. In the dry season, the Tarangire River is the only permanent source of water. Tarangire NP is 2850 square kilometres in size, making it the sixth largest park in Tanzania. It offers the highest concentration of wildlife after the Serengeti.

Tarangire is known for its Baobab trees and the large herds of elephants that can be seen from up close. Other animals that can be seen in Tarangire are: wildebeests, zebras, buffaloes, gazelles, warthogs, impalas, pythons, lions, leopards and almost 500 species of birds.

Rift Valley

The Great Rift Valley is the world's most famous valley and stretches from the Middle East to Mozambique. In Tanzania the Rift Valley has created a unique environment that combines lakes, mountains, volcanos and has a very abundant wildlife. The environment of the Rift Valley is a great example of how many natural systems can be intertwined, and is therefore the perfect place to visit for nature lovers.

150 CORNERS ROAD

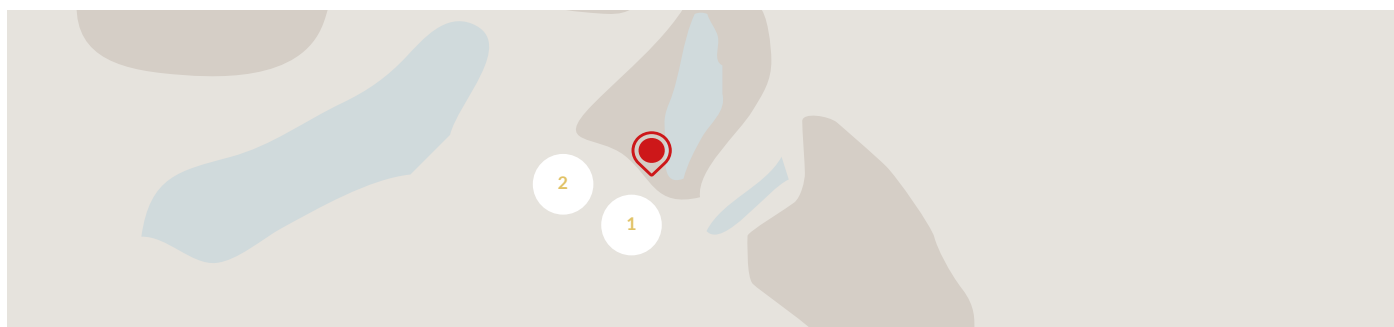
Located on Mount Magara you will find the most winding road in Tanzania. This road leads to/via Mbulu in the Manyara region to Karatu in about 100 km. The 150 corners road was established during colonial time by the Germans and was used to pass with horses. As the name suggests, the road starts with a climb of about 10 km and makes 150 corners. The road starts at 980 metres and has its peak at 1150 metres. After reaching the peak you will drive through breathtaking African landscapes. You will see intriguing farming techniques from the Iraqw tribe, such as cultivation terraces at stair step width! The environment is very fertile. The landscapes and vegetation varies along the way, and you will see many honey logs and beehives.



THE ROMAN CATHOLIC DIOCESE OF MBULU

Established in 1943 in the city of Mbulu as an apostolic prefecture and in 1953 promoted as the Diocese of Mbulu. It is one of the largest cathedrals in the region. In the vast landscape, the cathedral is a striking sight, due to its distinctive design and the 4 towers that suddenly dominate the landscape and will welcome you warmly.

DEVELOPMENT:

The Lake Manyara Biosphere Reserve, where Africa Safari Rift Valley is located, has a human population of over 250 thousand people. The ethnic groups found in this area are the Maasai, Iraqw and Barbaig, where the most important socio-economic activities are pastoralism and agriculture. Most of the immigrants in this area depend on tourism, whereas the Reserve receives around 80% of all the tourists visiting Tanzania. The tourism in this area is mainly based on nature tourism activities such as hiking, biking, day and/or night game drives and photographic tourism. The tourism industry gives all kinds of benefits such as creating jobs, foreign exchange, attraction to small and medium sized local businesses and creating funds which are used for several ecological activities around the Lake Manyara Biosphere Reserve.

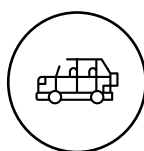

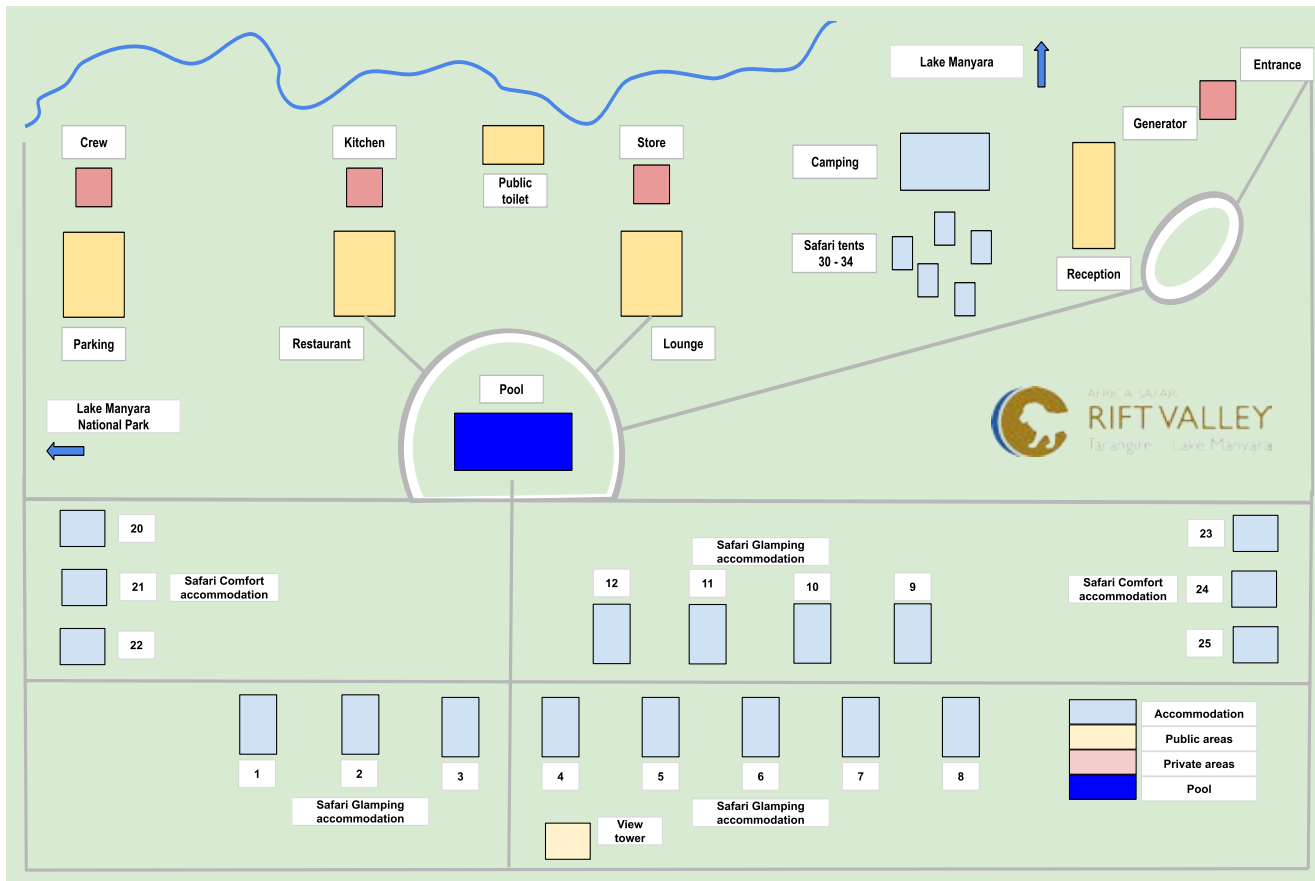

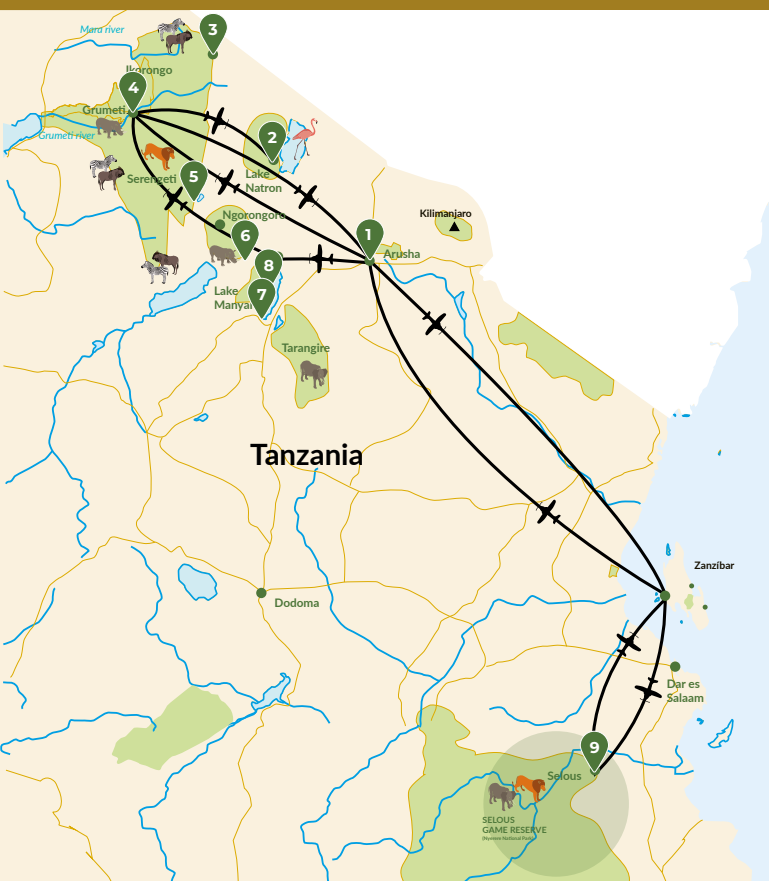
