

Africa Safari Selous is more than an accommodation, as a stay here is an unrivalled safari experience that you are unlikely to find anywhere else. Located just outside the Selous G.R./Nyerere National Park in southern Tanzania, the property is spacious. Much of the original vegetation has been retained, and respect for the environment is reflected in each of the carefully constructed rooms. The waterhole that the restaurant overlooks could well provide unexpected views!

Africa Safari Selous has accommodation for every budget; ranging from pre-built Safari tents to Banda Bungalows to Pool Bungalows. The most striking accommodations are the 24 'mud bandas' built based on Boma's, the traditional houses of the Maasai people. They are a perfect

combination of culture and comfort, and an experience not to be missed during your visit to Selous G.R./Nyerere National Park. The Pool Bungalows are spaciously laid out around the swimming pool with umbrellas and sun loungers, and are air-conditioned. The large size of the rooms makes them perfect for families or smaller groups of friends enjoying their travel adventure together. The bathrooms in these bungalows are naturally aerated and environmentally friendly lined with bamboo, they are a unique feature in themselves.

The centrally located campfire is a great place to socialise in the evening and share stories of your adventures.

LOCATION

Selous Game Reserve/Nyerere National Park

Africa Safari Selous lies just outside the Selous G.R./Nyerere National Park in Tanzania, near the famous Rufiji River, and is accessible by road and by air. The nearest airstrip is only a 12-minutes drive, right next to the Mtemere entrance gate. The accommodation can be reached within a 30-min flight from Zanzibar, a 35-min flight from Dar, and 6 hours by road from Dar es Salaam.



Banda Bungalow

The Banda Bungalow is a 49 m² accommodation located in the forest on the premises, with one king-size bed and one single bed. An extra single bed can be added (on request). A bathroom with a washbasin, shower and toilet, ample storage space and a small terrace, where you can relax, read a book or view your safari photos, complete the room. The outside construction is traditional, but inside you will find all the comforts. The swimming pool is within walking distance.

The African wild dogs in Selous

The vast Selous Game Reserve offers the perfect habitat for the rare and energetic African wild dog. The largest population in the world lives here. Wild dogs are democratic and social, and gather in packs of about ten individuals and sometimes more. They are opportunistic predators that hunt medium-sized ruminants, such as gazelles.

No two wild dogs have the same mark, making it easy to identify individuals. Their remarkably large ears serve not only to hear well but also to cool the photogenic animal, just like the elephant.

From the towering trees to the vibrant birdlife and the big game to the little creatures, they will reveal the secrets of the African bush and help you appreciate the intricate balance of life in this ecosystem. During the bushwalk, you will have the opportunity to observe and learn about the environment firsthand. You will see the diversity of plant life, including trees, shrubs, and grasses, and learn about their ecological roles. You will also have a chance to spot and identify different species of birds, insects, and other animals that call this place home.

DEVELOPMENTS

In 2019, Tanzania's new and largest national park was established in the northern part of Selous Game Reserve. This was decided by the Government of Tanzania to further develop tourism in southern Tanzania. With support from the World Bank, protected area management is being strengthened in terms of infrastructure development, community empowerment and other conservation needs. The development of nature-based tourism contributes to the diversification of livelihoods in the surrounding communities.






